The Roofing Contractors Association of California (RCAC) is a nonprofit 501(c)(6) professional organization dedicated to the protection and advancement of the California roofing industry in legislative, regulatory, and business affairs. Founded in 1949, RCAC serves as a link between roofing contractors, roofing industry affiliate organizations, state agencies, and the State Legislature.

Legislative Advocacy: As your voice in Sacramento, RCAC fights for the best interests of roofing contractors statewide. During the 2007-08 legislative session, RCAC monitored the progress of 103 bills addressing health care reform, workers' compensation, career technical education, public contracting, apprenticeship, energy conservation standards, indemnity in construction contracts, wrap-up insurance, and employer hiring responsibilities (specifically with respect to illegal immigrants).

Information: RCAC provides you with timely information and guidance on critical legal and technical issues, such as Proposition 65 litigation, cool roof regulations, workers' compensation insurance, and fall protection. Members receive a quarterly publication, *California Roofing*, and electronic updates covering legislation, industry news, business related topics and upcoming events. Members can also go online at www.rcacal.com for important news on legislative issues, education announcements and state and regulatory bulletins.
